



New Laws on Solid Waste Hauling

The State of Michigan has a series of new state laws regarding waste hauling. The new laws impact the type of solid waste you are allowed to put curbside for solid waste collection. Please take a moment to go over the new guidelines:

- Beverage containers not redeemed for the deposit must be recycled. It is no longer legal to include these containers in your solid waste refuse.
- Waste Management will no longer be able to dispose of tires curbside. You can recycle tires through various local dealers. Contact the DPW for further information.
- Compost/yard waste should never be put with your solid waste. It is illegal to dispose of yard waste in landfills. Yard waste consists of grass clippings, brush, leaves, and tree limbs. Please utilize the yard waste services you are provided by Waste Management and dispose of yard waste in the proper manner. Yard Waste collection runs from April through the end of November

These new laws are meant to protect our environment. It is important that you adhere to the new rules set by The State of Michigan. Obviously, failure to do so will result in your solid waste not being collected by Waste Management.
