YES <input type="radio"/> NO <input type="radio"/>	<b>MILLAGE REAUTHORIZATION PROPOSAL CHARTER AMENDMENT CITY OF WIXOM</b>  This amendment will reauthorize the levy of new additional millage in the amount of not to exceed 1.15 mills for 15 years, 2011 through 2025, inclusive, for the sole and exclusive purpose of providing additional revenues for routine and ongoing maintenance of local roads and streets under the City's jurisdiction in the City. It is estimated that if levied, 1.15 mills would raise approximately \$862,579 when first levied in 2011. YES <input type="radio"/> NO <input type="radio"/>	<b>CHARTER AMENDMENT CITY OF WIXOM</b>  This amendment will authorize the levy of new additional millage in the amount of not to exceed .30 mill for 15 years, 2009 through 2023, inclusive, solely for construction, maintenance, repair and rehabilitation of safety paths and sidewalks and under the jurisdiction of the City. It is estimated that if levied, .30 mill would raise approximately \$262,000.00 when first levied in 2009. <b>PROPOSAL SECTION</b>	<b>COUNTY</b> <b>A PROPOSED MODIFICATION TO THE OAKLAND COUNTY MERIT SYSTEM COVERING THE EMPLOYEES OF THE COUNTY OF OAKLAND THAT UPDATES THE SYSTEM FROM ITS ORIGINAL 1966 VERSION AS EXPLAINED BY COUNTY RESOLUTION #08119.</b>  The proposed modification would:  Implement gender-neutral language.  Update terms used to reflect the current composition of the County committees and Government.  Clarify language to reflect the practice approved by the County to allow for top five scores on all examinations, including ties or when scores are banded or grouped, when considering selection for promotion into a vacancy.  Remove language that lists Oakland County residency as a requirement for workers and candidates to reflect current practice.  Update language to allow for communications through means other than U. S. Mail (e.g. allow electronic communications).  Add a sixth member to the current Personnel Appeal Board and allow hearings to be conducted with 3 members present (1 Board of Commissioner member, 1 employee-elected member, and 1 Member at Large) so two hearings can take place simultaneously. This would allow for quicker resolution of appeals and reduce case backlog.  Establish grounds and a procedure for recusal/disqualification of appeal board members on particular hearings and establish a process for replacing the disqualified member.
